The University of Southern Indiana is organizing a team for the 2002 Evansville Komen Race for the Cure. Team organizers are making a special effort this year to include USI students and alumni in their team, the USI Screening Eagles.

USI has entered a team in the local race for the past three years and last year the team won awards for most on-line registrations and for the fastest growing team. The numbers went from 90 participants in 2000 to over 550 participants in 2001! The team included the men's and women's basketball teams, representatives of Student Government, Greek life, campus clubs and organizations, alumni, family, and friends.

One of the challenges facing organizers is that the team registration deadline of September 5 comes very quickly after students return to campus in late August, leaving little time for students to register.
