Tri-State youngsters are offered a variety of fun learning opportunities ranging from the ancient dinosaur to modern space travel in "Super Summer for Kids" classes at the University of Southern Indiana and Evansville Day School.

In addition, there is the Advanced Computer Day Camp the week of July 18 for youngsters entering grades seven through nine, and a new feature this year, a one-day trip to St. Louis on August 10, when children age 7 and up can visit the Magic House and the Science Center in Forest Park.

Magic House is a participatory museum where students sample the mystical world of magic through hands-on activities. The Science Center pioneers the concept of informal science education through 25 all-weather exhibits demonstrating basic principles of light, energy, sound, weather, and natural history. It also features outdoor exhibits involving mechanical and physical concepts. The \$45 fee covers transportation, admission fees, and lunch and supper.

The regular Super Summer classes, sponsored by USI's Office of Continuing Education, are one-week sessions that start each Monday, July 13 through 25. Most of the classes will meet from 9 to 11:30 a.m. The registration fee for USI classes is \$42 per child, \$45 if special equipment is used; the fee for Day School classes is \$45.
