GASOLINE DISCOUNT FOR ISUE FACULTY AND STAFF

Mr. Kissinger, owner of Kissinger's C & M Texaco Station at Highway 62 West and Red Bank Road, has offered to extend a discount of up to \$.02 per full gallon of gasoline to all ISUE Faculty and Staff. The discount will not be in effect during "Gas War" conditions when "regular" sells for 32.9 or less per gallon.

This discount will be given to all faculty and staff having a current Faculty-Staff parking sticker and is a discount off the meter price and not in lieu of other premiums.

Mr. Kissinger has advised that he offers free pickup and delivery to the campus on other service needs and has a mechanic on duty at the station from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

These rate increases have resulted from the increase in costs of hospitalization and medical services during the past year. The rates were approved by the Indiana State University Board of Trustees at the May 20 meeting.

The payroll deductions reflecting the increased premium rates will be made beginning with the June 30 payroll check for faculty members on a 12-pay plan and fiscal administrative staff. Faculty members on a 10-pay plan and administrative staff on ten-month appointments will have the new summer deductions taken on the June 30 payroll check. Bi-weekly and regular hourly deductions will be made beginning with the June payroll checks.

NEW BOOKSTORE POLICY

Effective July 1, 1972, the University Bookstore will no longer give the 10% discount to university employees. Hereafter, any special discounts will be applicable to both students and university employees.
