Alethea Hunter named USI Student Leader of the Month

Alethea N. Hunter, a 1995 Harrison High School graduate, has been named Student Leader of the Month for September, in the O'Daniel Leadership Academy program at the University of Southern Indiana. The program was started in 1996 to honor the students who provide leadership for student and University programs.

Hunter volunteers in the EXCEL Mentoring Program in USI's Multicultural Center and serves as treasurer for the Black Student Union. Pamela Hopson, director of the Multicultural Center who nominated her for this honor, said that Hunter exhibits true qualities of a leader. She assisted with setting up the Mentoring Program schedule for the entire academic year and designed the format of each session of the program. Hopson said that Hunter's goal was to help under-represented students on campus.
