SESSION # 11 MINUTES OF THE 1977-78 FACULTY COUNCIL MEETINGS

1. Approval of Previous Minutes

The minutes of Session #10 were approved as amended.

2. President's Remarks

Dr. Rice showed and described a plan for the HYPER building.

He announced that Student Union Board Day will be held on the 19th of April; alternate rain day the 20th. Classes will be cancelled from noon to 6:00 p.m.

President Rice said that President Landini presented a general description of the proposed guidelines for 1978-79 salaries at the Board of Trustees Meeting on April 8, 1978.

President Rice felt the Economic Benefits Committee had done a good job on their report. He feels the long range impact is beneficial. Dr. Rivers was concerned about the usefulness of such a committee and the resulting frustration of committee members when their report was accepted after the Board of Trustees had already reached decisions about some of the concerns.

Dr. Petranek asked Dr. Rice to respond in writing to the resolution on the space committee passed in Session # 7, February 8, 1978, of the Faculty Council meetings.
