FEE WAIVER POLICY. The Board of Trustees of Indiana State University, meeting May 7, approved a fee waiver policy for dependent children of faculty and staff. This fee waiver of \$250.00 per academic year, for a maximum of eight semesters, is provided for dependent children of full-time faculty and staff. It will be extended to full-time undergraduate students and limited to dependent children who are not participating in a contingent fee waiver program. HEALTH NOTE: Since poison ivy does not grow wild in Europe, the continent first heard about the skin disease in 1609 when Captain John Smith, protegee of Pocahontas, described it. "The yvie," he said, "causeth redness, itching and lastly blisters. Because for a time it is somewhat painful, and in aspect dangerous, it hath gotten itself an ill name."

Throughout our history, this "ill name" has been well deserved. During construction of the Union Pacific Railroad, 1853-1856, it was a major source of annoyance and delay. More recently it has been estimated that 80% of all lost time illnesses among members of the Civilian Conservation Corps were due to ivy poisoning. This "botanical Judas" also accounted for 15% of all dispensary cases at one Army training camp during World War II.

A Japanese relative of poison ivy, the lac tree, is used extensively in the production of lacquered objects. As a result, there have been many cases of skin disorders among Americans using mah-jongg sets and oriental trays right in their own homes. Its other relatives include the more likeable cashew and pistachio nut trees.

People most apt to be trapped by poison ivy this summer are farmers, hikers, suburban gardeners, picnickers, and the ISUE grounds crew.

HEALTH NOTE: (con.) Their best weapon against poison ivy is knowledge. They should know how to recognize and avoid it. Or, if they must handle it, how to do it safely. (continued next week)
