What historical factors underlie and have shaped contemporary concern about "conduct" on the campus? If a statement of professional ethics is needed, who and by what procedure should it be formulated? If a statement of professional ethics is needed, what should its content be? The panel discussion will also include a review of the work to date for the ad hoc committee currently working on a policy statement concerning the conduct of faculty in relation to campus dissent. The panel members for this session are: Dean Rice, Dr. Fairless, Dr. Mussard, Dr. Bigham, and Col. Wardner. There will be discussion and questions from the floor.
