1. PRE-REGISTRATION:

The administration is planning a program of pre-registration to make it possible for students to have better opportunities to select their program and courses for the next semester.

2. FACULTY MEETING:

The agenda of the meeting will consist of a review of deliberation of the faculty advisory committee to date, and a determination of the wishes of the faculty with regard to changes which the faculty may wish to make in the representation on the committee.

3. PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY POLICY:

Faculty members may wish to consider membership in the ISTA, in order to obtain the \$100,000.00 liability protection for professional personnel in the course of duties as an administrator or instructor member of a faculty or teaching staff of an educational institution. Mr. Wright has the application forms for dues for the ISTA. The liability policy is a part of the membership privileges.

4. UNITED FUND REPORT:

We received a very nice note of thanks from the United Fund for the response from the Indiana State University, Evansville Campus. The total amount donated by this campus was \$384.00, making an average per contributor of approximately \$25.60. This is quite an increase over last year.

5. NOVEMBER 11, FOOTBALL GAME:
