USI STUDENTS ELECTED TO STATE ORGANIZATION

Two Evansville students at the University of Southern Indiana -- Todd Slagle of 250 S. Sonntag and Jody Wilmes of 1429 Olympic Court -- have been elected to state offices with the Indiana Student Education Association (ISEA).

Slagle, a senior elementary education major and president of SEA at USI, was elected president of ISEA.

Wilmes, a junior elementary education major and president-elect of the USI chapter, was named Region IV representative and will coordinate activities for USI and five other schools -- University of Evansville, Oakland City, Hanover, Vincennes, and IU-Southeast.
