Two one-day business seminars also have openings: Collect the Debt and Keep the Customer, Monday, March 16, and Introduction to Statistical Process Control, Wednesday, March 18. The debt collection course will be taught by C. Connie Firm, president of CMR Ltd. of Minneapolis; enrollment is limited to allow individual attention to credit-collection problems. The SPC class is part of a Total Quality Management package offered this spring. The course is ideally suited to those who have little or no experience in SPC.
