Each USI housing resident who participates in Housing Renewal Week will receive 100 programming points. Programming points are collected throughout the year and convert to Programming Bucks for the Programming Auction held at the end of the spring semester. This year's auction is scheduled for April 18. At the auction, students may bid on such items as televisions, other electronics, and housing upgrades.
