Wayne Boultinghouse is concluding his second year as Athletic Director and Basketball Coach of Indiana State University Evansville. He joined ISUE following a five year service to his alma mater (1964) the University of Evansville.

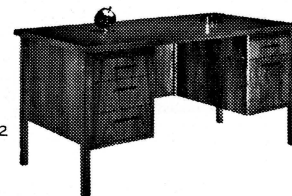

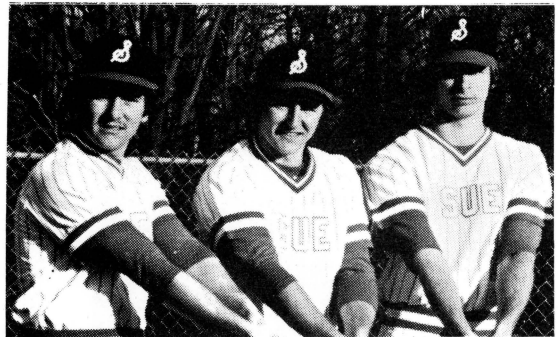
