Matthew Graham will read from his newly-

published collection of poems, *1946* -- many of them inspired by life in Evansville and southern Indiana -- in a Liberal Arts Forum at 2 p.m. Wednesday, October 16, in the University Center at the University of Southern Indiana. In a reception following the program, Graham will sign copies of the book. The forum is free and open to the public.

1946 was released recently by Galileo Press Ltd. of Baltimore, Maryland, which also published Graham's first collection of poetry, *New World Architecture*, in 1985. Graham is associate professor of English/creative writing at USI. He has a master's degree from John Hopkins University and a Master of Fine Arts degree from the Iowa Writers Workshop. He has received two literary fellowships from the Indiana Arts Commission and his poems have appeared in many literary magazines.
