**Super Summer classes for children offered on campus**

The Super Summer program sponsored by the USI Office of Extended Services will offer programs in science, crafts, computers, art, and reading for ages 4 to 14 the week of June 18 to June 22. Classes will be offered in the Conference Center and in the Technology Center.

A sample of the classes follows:

*Scientific Kids, meets 9 to 11:30 a.m.*

Young science wizards will dabble in the life, earth, physical and chemical sciences. Lots of take-home projects will be completed during the week. Grades 2 to 4.

*Meet Eric Carle, meets 9 to 11:30 a.m.*

The books of Eric Carle (*The Very Hungry Caterpillar, The Very Quiet Cricket*) will be the basis for a variety of hands-on learning experiences including art, music, science, and beginning reading and math skills. Ages 4 to 6 years.

*Crafts and Creations, meets 9 to 11:30 a.m.*

Messes that kids love, including new projects and some old favorites—making candles, dying socks with home-made dye, and designing photo album pages are a few of the activities that will teach lots of useful skills while increasing creativity. Grades 3 to 5.

*Crafts to Grow For, meets 12:30 p.m. to 3 p.m.*

Children will learn basic gardening skills, how to identify flowers and herbs, and create practical garden crafts, a leaf-print clay pot, gourd bowl, seed holder and more. Grades 3 to 6.
