**Sports workshops at USI
part of summer enrichment program**

USI will host roughly 160 fifth-, sixth-, and seventh-graders on four Thursdays in June as part of a summer enrichment program operated by the Evansville-Vanderburgh School Corp. and the 21st Century Community Learning Center.

The students from the Harwood Middle School area will participate in four activities each time they are on campus from 12:30 to 3:30 p.m. June 6, 13, 20, and 27.

The students will participate in groups of 40 as they rotate through the activities including swimming, basketball, volleyball, nature hikes, soccer, tennis, and kickball.

Students will use the Physical Activities Center (PAC) basketball courts, the PAC pool, the tennis courts, the lawn near Rice Library, and the nature trails in the Bent Twig Outdoor Learning Center. In the event of inclement weather, the students will be organized into groups in the PAC.

The sports workshops will serve as a supplement to the five-week enrichment program at Harwood Middle School that also includes art, technology, reading, horticulture, physical fitness, keyboarding, and math.
