



**JULY 4 HOLIDAY.** University offices will be open Monday, July 3 but will close Tuesday, July 4 to celebrate the fourth of July holiday.

**DENTAL HYGIENE STUDENTS RECEIVE HIGH SCORES.** ISUE dental hygiene spring graduates recently received their scores from the National Board Examination taken in April.

Based on a national curve, a passing score for the examination was 75%. Scores of the ISUE graduates ranged from 82-94%.

State Board examinations will be taken later this summer.

### STAFF BENEFITS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JULY 1978.

1. Blue Cross-Blue Shield

Effective July 10, 1978, the University Group Blue Cross-Blue Shield rates will be increased approximately 12.3%. The University will pay for the full amount of this increase; employee payroll deduction amounts will not change for the 1978-79 policy year. The University contribution will be approximately 73% of the total premium cost.

2. Equitable Major Medical/Dental

Effective July 1, 1978, the Equitable Major Medical/Dental Coverage will be expanded to include "extended care benefits". This coverage includes rehabilitative care in a qualified nursing care facility following a period of hospitalization. Custodial care in a nursing home is not covered.

The Dental benefits maximum will be increased from \$600.00 to \$800.00 per person per calendar year. Orthodontia benefits will also be increased to a maximum of \$800.00 per course of treatment plans initiated after July 1, 1978.

3. Equitable Life Insurance

The University will assume the full cost of the first \$11,000.00 of coverage under the Equitable Life Insurance program effective July 1, 1978. Presently, the University pays the first \$8,000.00 of coverage in full. The employee will continue to pay \$.34 per thousand for coverage in excess of \$11,000.00.
