## 1990 VOLLEYBALL OUTLOOK

The 1990 University of Southern Indiana volleyball team will be very similar to the 1989 version, but with some new twists which will allow the Lady Screaming Eagles to put it all together in 1990.

With a brand new squad in 1989, the Lady Eagles finished with a 10-21 record overall and a 3-6 record in the Great Lakes Valley Conference for fifth place, just missing the playoffs. The Lady Eagles also took their opponents into 11 four-or-five-game matches losing six.

This year, Dawn VanHall, USI's third-year head coach, is optimistic that after a year of being together, the Lady Eagles will be able to win more of those four-or-five-game matches and turn in a season over .500.

Leading the way for the returners is senior setter Krystal Green. Green, also captain of the squad again this year, led the team in 1989 with 729 assists and 61 digs, while ranking second on the team in service aces with 35.

Other returners who will help lead the way and convert Green's passes is senior outside hitter Joy Normington and sophomore middle hitter Leah Parsons. Normington led the team with 259 kills and 44 service aces last season.

Parsons, who continued to improve as last year progressed, finished the year with 232 kills, and led the team in hitting percentage with .261, solo blocks with 108 and assisted blocks with 61.

Also returning at the middle hitter position is junior Cindy Billings, a three-year starter. Billings was second on the team in kills with 233, solo blocks with 58, digs with 55 and third in hitting percentage at .198.

The final ingredient could be the one new player on the squad, freshman outside hitter Sherri Kaiser. Kaiser is a graduate of North Harrison H.S. in Ramsey, Ind. where she won ten varsity letters in four years in volleyball, basketball, and tennis and was All Mid-Southern Conference in 1988 and 1989 for volleyball.

One change this season will be the change of the emphasis placed on defense. "In the past our defense was good and our offense adequate. This year, we are concentrating on defense and making it our priority," said VanHall.

"The offense is always there and good defense will create the offensive opportunities. The returning starting hitters, Parsons, Normington, (Lisa) Yockey and Billings are all hitting the ball better, and Kaiser is hitting harder than all of them."

Also returning from last season are hitters Angie Anderson, a sophomore, who had 30 kills and a .155 hitting percentage and Julie Slemer, a senior, who saw action in 18 games, averaging almost a kill a game with 14.

Backing up Green at setter will be sophomore setter Denise Rossa. "Green will set in the 5-1 formation, but she will move a hitter when Rossa enters and we play the 6-2," said VanHall.

The one problem which could hamper the squad this season is the number of players. VanHall explained, "Lack of players could hurt us in preparing, and injuries could be a problem. To avoid these problems we are getting the players as fit as possible."

5'10"...Sophomore....Middle Hitter...Mt. Vernon, Ind.

Played in 40 games as a freshman...had 30 kills and a hitting percentage of .155 in 1989...was an All-Conference performer and given the "Big Blocker" award in 1986 at Mt. Vernon H.S...an all-around athlete who also won letters in basketball and track...in basketball, she was named Defensive Player of the Year in 1985-86 and 1986-87...majoring in elementary education.

Cindy Billings...#7

5'8"...Junior...Middle Hitter...Newburgh, Ind.

A three-year starter who had 233 kills and a hitting percentage of .198, 58 solo blocks and 55 digs in 1989...was M.V.P. and All-Conference her senior season at Castle H.S...also lettered in track and basketball...in basketball, she was captain and All-Conference in 1987-88...named Most Athletic Female at Castle H.S. in 1988...majoring in communications.

Krystal Green...#1...Captain

5'7"...Senior....Setter/Outside Hitter...Boonville, Ind.

Returns this season as the USI captain...led the team with 729 assists and digs with 61 and ranked second in service aces with 35 in 1989...was All-Conference in 1986 and 1987 at Boonville in volleyball and basketball...was named M.V.P., All-Area and honorable mention All-State along with All-Conference honors in basketball in her senior season...also a member of the USI softball team...majoring in elementary education.

Sheri Kaiser...#9

5'10"...Freshman...Outside Hitter...Corydon, Ind.

Comes to USI from North Harrison H.S. in Ramsey, Ind...while at NHHS, she won ten letters in volleyball, basketball and tennis...in 1988 and 1989 she received the Best Hitter, Best Blocker and Serve Receive awards and was All-Mid-Southern Conference in those two years for volleyball...was the 1990 Academic Athletic award winner...majoring in business.

Joy Normington...#8

5'9"...Senior....Outside Hitter...Indianapolis, Ind.

Led the team in team in kills with 259 and service aces with 44 in 1989...transferred to USI from a Southwestern Michigan team which was seventh in the national tournament in 1987 and second in the regional in 1988...in 1986 she was co-captain, All-County and honorable mention All-Metro on a state finalist team...majoring in business administration.

Leah Parsons...#13  
6'0"...Sophomore....Middle Hitter...Loogootee, Ind.

Played in 108 games as a freshman and led the team in hitting percentage with .261, solo blocks with 108, assisted blocks with 61, and also finished third with 232 kills in 1989...came to USI from Loogootee H.S., where she was named M.V.P. and All-Conference team member in 1987 and 1988, while leading the team in blocking and hitting...also played tennis at Loogootee winning two letters...majoring in marketing.

Denise Rossa...#11  
5'3"...Sophomore....Setter...DeMotte, Ind.

Saw action in 43 games as a freshman, mainly as a defensive specialist...an All-Conference and All-Area performer in 1987-88 at Kankakee Valley H.S. where she led the volleyball squad to a final 16 finish...an all-around athlete winning letters in track and basketball...majoring in education.

Julie Slemer...#10  
6'0"...Senior....Middle Hitter...Glen Carbon, Ill.

Saw limited action last year and finished with 18 kills and nine blocks...played two years for the USI women's basketball team and was named the 1987-88 Most Improved Player on the USI women's team...named M.V.P. in 1986 and 1987 in volleyball and All-Metro in 1987 at Edwardsville H.S...majoring in business administration.

Lisa Yockey...#12  
5'10"...Junior....Outside Hitter...Boonville, Ind.

Action was limited to only 42 games last year due to a broken foot, but still made appearances in 42 games and had 84 kills... was All-Conference in 1987 when Boonville H.S. finished in the top eight in the state...majoring in Biology.

#### HEAD COACH DAWN VANHALL

Dawn VanHall begins her third season as the head coach of the USI volleyball team after a 10-21 record and fifth place finish in the Great Lakes Valley Conference with a 3-6 record last season. In her two years at USI, VanHall has a career record of 28-39 as a head coach.

A native of Evansville, VanHall graduated from Western Michigan University in Kalamazoo, Michigan, where she played volleyball for four years and was selected to the All-Mid-American Conference team in 1979. She received a Bachelor of Science degree with honors in computer science from WMU in 1982.

Prior to coming to USI, VanHall coached volleyball in Michigan at Kalamazoo College Schoolcraft High School. Returning to Evansville, VanHall coached at Bosse High School in Evansville for two years. She also coached a USVBA club team for five years.
