

USI's spring 2016 Dean's List released

In recognition of outstanding academic achievement, the Dean's List has been released for the 2016 spring semester at the University of Southern Indiana. Dr. Ronald Rochon, provost, reported that 2,082 undergraduates were named to the Dean's List.

Semester honors are not awarded to master's degree students or doctoral students.

Undergraduate students must achieve a 3.5 or better grade point average (on a 4.0 system) to be named to the Dean's List. Students earning no IN (incomplete) or Z (missing) grades for the term, and earning letter grades of computable point value (Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory and Pass/No Pass graded courses do not apply) in 12 or more semester hours, with a semester grade point average between 3.5 and 4.0 are named to the list.

The Dean's List is arranged by each student's hometown (by state and city), according to the address he/she has provided to the University. A student's name may be listed under Evansville if the student supplied an Evansville mailing address. The Dean's list may be accessed by clicking the link below.
