

A 15-week course on Retirement Plans will be offered for the spring section in the University of Southern Indiana Office of Continuing Education's Certified Employee Benefits Specialist (CEBS) program. The class will meet on Tuesdays, starting February 15, at Bristol-Myers USPNG Institute, 2404 Pennsylvania.

The nationally-recognized CEBS is cosponsored by the International Foundation of Employee Benefit Plans and the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania. The 10-course curriculum spells opportunity, whether you are a benefits manager, consultant, insurance company representative, trust officer, administrator, attorney, or investment specialist.

Diane Bender, a lawyer, CPA, and partner in the law firm of Kahn, Dees, Donovan and Kahn, will be the instructor, covering contemporary fundamentals of benefit plans with an emphasis on the defined benefit approach to providing retirement income.
