Presidential impeachment panel to be held at USI

A public panel to discuss the pros and cons of the impeachment and trial of the President will be held at 6 p.m. on Thursday, January 28 in the University Center's Carter Hall at University of Southern Indiana. Members of the local community and USI faculty will debate the issue followed by interaction with the audience.

Panelists Dr. David Drebushenko, associate professor of philosophy; Dr. Stephen J. Sullivan, assistant professor of philosophy; and Dr. Betty L. Hart, professor of English will argue against impeachment and removal of President William Clinton. Arguing in agreement for impeachment and removal of President Clinton will be local attorneys Leslie C. Shively and Christopher D. Lee joined by James Doyle, a USI student of sociology and criminal justice. Dr. J. Wayne Rinks, associate professor of communications, will serve as moderator.
