The 1991 Diet Pepsi/Schnucks Women's Walk in support of women's athletics at the University of Southern Indiana will be held Saturday, October 19. Women's basketball Coach Chancellor Dugan, coordinator, said 34 team captains have been selected and all interested women are invited to join them in helping to reach this year's goal of \$12,000.

The group will gather below the University Center bridge for registration at 8:30 a.m. They will set off at 9 a.m. on the 1.5-mile walk from the University Center to the University Home, where they will be guests of Betty Rice, wife of the University president, for a continental breakfast. Carol Baker of Boonville, wife of USI Trustee Bruce Baker, is chairman for the event.

The walk has corporate sponsorship this year from Diet Pepsi and Schnucks Markets. Grand prizes will be awarded in a drawing -- adult team members who raise at least \$100 will be eligible to win either a weekend trip to St. Louis or a recliner from L.B. Jones furniture store; student team members who raise at least \$50 will be eligible to win a USI sweatsuit.
