Dr. Marwan A. Wafa, acting chair of the Administrative, Decision Sciences, and Business Education Department at the University of Southern Indiana, will be the next speaker in the Silver Anniversary International Speakers Series at the University.

He will discuss "The American Presence in the Middle East and the Iraqi/Kuwaiti Conflict" in a public lecture at 7 p.m. Wednesday, September 12, in the University Dining Room.

Dr. Wafa is a Palestinian who is Jordanian by nationality and was born and raised in Kuwait. He received a B.S. in civil engineering from Kuwait University in 1980 and worked in various construction projects prior to coming to the U.S. in the fall of 1982 to enroll at Clemson University in South Carolina. Dr. Wafa received an M.S. and Ph.D. in industrial management from Clemson.

Dr. Wafa joined the USI faculty in the fall of 1986. He is a member of SCORE/ACE, Decision Sciences Institute, and the American Production and Inventory Control Society (APICS). He is faculty advisor for the APICS student affiliate at USI.
