USI singers plan spring programs

Spring programs are planned by choral groups at the University of Southern Indiana, beginning with the annual spring concert at 7 p.m. Saturday, April 12, by the Mid-America Singers and Show Choir. The concert will be held in Forum I of the Wright Administration Building. Tickets are \$5 for general admission, \$3 for children (12-under).

In addition, the USI Concert Choir will present its annual free concert at 3 p.m. Sunday, April 27, at St. Boniface Catholic Church, 2031 W. Michigan Street. The choir will present works by Bruckner, Brahms, Gorczycki, Lekberg, Henderson, Hayes, Rutter, and Craig -- USI music director Daniel R. Craig, who has composed music especially for this event.

The Mid-America Singers' spring concert will be one of a series in April, as they continue preparations to tour Poland May 11-25, their second visit to the country. The Singers will be at Evansville Central High School April 8 and Mt. Vernon (Illinois) High School on April 22; they also are slated to make two appearances at employee functions for General Electric in Mt. Vernon, Indiana.

The Singers' farewell concert, prior to the May 11 departure for Poland, will be held at 3 p.m. Sunday, May 4, in St. Boniface Church. The concert is free and open to the public, but donations will be accepted to help students defray their costs on the trip to Poland.
