UPDATE ON THE HPER BUILDING. Earlier this year, ISUE received a \$3.3 million bonding authorization from the General Assembly for the HPER building. Apparent low bids submitted June 22 totaled \$3.8 million, necessitating an ISU Board of Trustees decision to ask for readvertisement for bids beginning August 2.

In the meantime, University officials are studying building plans with the

architect and engineers to determine additional changes and bidding alternates for the project.

It is hoped that this process will only delay activity by one month, and the project can be completed in November or December, 1979.

Plans for a fund drive will be undertaken to finance portions of the building, but these plans will be deferred until specific building realities are known.
