FACULTY COUNCIL MEETINGS

The meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m.

1. Election of Vice Chairman and Secretary

Professor Charles Barber was elected Vice Chairman and Professor George Abshier, Secretary.

2. Appointment of Members to Standing Committees

The Council approved the appointment of members to standing committees as indicated on the attached list of standing committees. Two Faculty Council alternates are yet to be elected by their respective divisions. A list of other university committees is also attached indicating ex-officio members and the new members appointed at this session.

Regarding the Promotions Committee, two of the representatives, by previous decision of the Faculty Council, will serve two-year terms (Dr. Frost and Dr. Mays) as this committee is instituting a system of two-year rotations.

It was pointed out that Science & Math, Allied Health, and Engineering Technology will operate as a group for purposes of serving on committees.

The Council appointed chairmen of standing committees as indicated on the attached list.

4. Announcements

Dr. Rice distributed a list of enrollment and academic space need projections and announced that the request for the HPER building will be presented to the Board of Trustees at the next meeting. (See attachment.) There was brief discussion of space needs.

There was brief discussion of the computer report and Dr. Rice indicated that plans have been completed to provide linkage with the computer on the Terre Haute campus without charge to ISUE for computer time.
