USI's Super Summer/Enrichment programs at Evansville Day School

University of Southern Indiana's Office of Continuing Education will hold Super Summer/Enrichment programs for children and adolescents at Evansville Day School, 3400 N. Green River Road, Monday - Friday, July 12 - 16. The variety of classes offered during the week is geared for children in grade levels PreK - 9.

Morning sessions will be held from 9 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. The class High in the Sky, children ages 4 - 6 years, will introduce students to simple concepts about flight, allow them to perform simple experiments, and explore space. Dinosaurs, Fossils will take children grades K - 3 on imaginary time travel to several prehistoric periods and introduce them to dinosaurs and to the lifestyle of cave dwellers. Media Mix will inspire participants in grades 6 - 9 and boost their artistic talents through cartooning, painting, and studying great artists and their work.

Afternoon sessions will be held 12:30 p.m. - 3 p.m. and include Adventures in Art for children in grades K - 1. Children will experience a variety of media as they paint, sculpt, and draw to create an array of process-based art projects. Dramatics for Kids offers children grades 5 - 9 an opportunity to work with professional actors and other stage artists from the USI summer musical programs presented at Lincoln Amphitheatre; and Your In Charge! is for children grades 6 - 8 who are just beginning to stay home alone or those who wish to begin a career in babysitting.

The summer program is coordinated by Ginger Ramsden, manager of Family, School, and Children's programs at USI. She said the reasons for holding programs at Evansville Day School involve Evansville's need for quality summer child-care and USI's efforts to help fill that need. She said, "The demand for quality summer children's programs has grown exponentially in the Evansville area in the past few years. By holding classes at Evansville Day School, we can provide a convenient enrichment opportunity for children across town from campus."

Faculty are local professionals and teachers.
