IN DOS, dBASE III+
COURSES AT USI

Openings still are available in the University of Southern Indiana's IBM-PC Disk Operating System (DOS) classes and a three-week course on dBASE III+, a powerful command-driven language for storing, modifying, printing, and deleting user-created databases such as mailing lists, customer files, and inventories.

The final two summer DOS classes will meet from 6 to 9 p.m. on July 12 and 14 and July 18 and 21; participants will learn to run programs, manage data and directories on disk, and protect against loss or damage of valuable data. The registration fee is \$65.

Students who have had a DOS course or who have a working knowledge of PCs will want to enroll in dBASE III+ classes, which will meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays, beginning July 19. Participants will learn to create, edit, practice data retrieval techniques, perform short systems analyses, and design projects. The registration fee is \$155.
