Sophocles' 5th century tragedy, "Oedipus the King," will be USI Theatre's final spring production, opening Thursday, April 13, at the USI Theatre, 3001 Igleheart Avenue.

Dr. James R. Blevins, dean of the School of Liberal Arts who will direct "Oedipus the King," said it is generally acknowledged to be the world's most carefully constructed tragedy. Aristotle, in his work on drama, Poetics, cited "Oedipus" to illustrate the requirements of tragedy.

William Hairston, who is familiar to USI Theatre audiences, will portray Oedipus. Brian Sajko, communications instructor who directs many of the USI Theatre productions, also will have a major role as the leader of the chorus. Dr. Blevins said they are using a timeless setting and costumes in an attempt to make it a work for all times and all places. Randy Smith is in charge of scenery and lighting.

"Oedipus the King" will be presented at 8 p.m. Thursday through Saturday, April 13-15 and 20-22, with a matinee performance at 2 p.m. on Sunday, April 16. In addition, a special performance will be presented at 9 a.m. on Wednesday, April 19, for gifted and talented high school seniors in the Evansville-Vanderburgh School Corporation.

Tickets are \$5 for the general public, \$3 for USI students, faculty, and staff. Dr. Blevins said reservations are appropriate since some USI students are being required to attend the play. Call (812) 464-1735 for reservations or information.
