# **HEAD COACH MIKE GOEDDE**

In 1998, Mike Goedde will be entering his fifth season as head baseball coach at the University of Southern Indiana. During Goedde's tenure as coach, he has a 122-80 overall record; 51-36 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference.

During the 1997 campaign, Goedde directed the Eagles to a 30-16 overall record and a 16-9 conference mark, missing the league divisional playoffs by a half game. At the conclusion of the season, he had led the Eagles to their ninth consecutive winning season, the 30-win mark for the fourth time in six seasons, and back into the regional races.

He successfully led the 1996 team to a 27-22 overall, 14-12 in the GLVC, while leading the 1995 team to a 29-23 record and a 10-8 GLVC record, just missing the GLVC Tournament each year.

In his first season, Goedde led the Eagles to a 36-19 record and berths in the Great Lakes Valley Conference and NCAA Division II Central Region tournaments.

Prior to coming to USI, Goedde was an assistant coach at the University of Evansville (UE) under Head Coach Jim Brownlee from 1986-1988 and 1990-1993.

While Goedde was at UE, the baseball team was the Midwestern Collegiate Conference champion in 1988 and 1990. In 1988, the pitching staff had the second best ERA in the country with a 2.99. This staff featured major league All-Star Andy Benes, who plays professionally in Major League Baseball.

In professional baseball, Goedde was signed as a pitcher in the fourth round of the 1983 draft by the Cincinnati Reds and spent three seasons in their farm system (1983-1985). In 1989, Goedde was a pitching instructor with the Cincinnati Reds organization in the Pioneer League at Billings, Mont.

The Evansville native graduated from UE with a degree in sports administration, and from Mater Dei High School.

In addition to his duties as baseball coach, Goedde also is a physical education instructor at USI.

Assistant Coach Chris Barney will begin his fifth season at USI as the hitting instructor and will work with the infielders and outfielders.

Barney joined Goedde's staff in 1993-94 after spending the 1992-93 year at Tusculum College in Greenville, TN. Prior to working at Tusculum, Barney spent three-and-a-half years (1989-92) with Tennessee Wesleyan College as an assistant coach. At both schools, he was responsible for daily practices, field maintenance, and fund raising projects.

Barney, a 1992 graduate of Tennessee Wesleyan with a degree in business administration, coached the Quincy Gems in their inaugural season and won a Central Illinois Collegiate League Tournament Championship in the summer of 1996.

# **VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH STEVE WAUGERMAN**

Volunteer Assistant Coach Steve Waugerman begins his second season with the Screaming Eagles.

A native of Bedford, PA, Waugerman competed collegiately as an infielder at Juniata College, which is an NCAA Division III school. He was a four-year letterwinner and was a member of the Middle Atlantic Conference Championship teams in 1990 and 1991 and the NCAA III Tournament team in 1990.

Waugerman also started his senior year in the football team's defensive backfield and was a choosen as a captain.

Graduating from Juniata in 1993 with a degree in business management, the native of Bedford, PA, is employed locally by Family Home Health Services in Evansville, IN, as systems administrator.
