Wetlands and water quality lecture at Wesselman Woods Nature Preserve

Dr. Paul K. Doss, chair of the Geology and Physics Department at University of Southern Indiana, will be featured speaker at the Evansville Audubon Society and the Evansville Flyfishing Club meeting at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, February 16 at the Wesselman Woods Nature Preserve. The topic "Wetlands and Water Quality" focuses on the diversity of wetland types, with specific examples from Indiana, the Midwest, and elsewhere in the country. Dr. Doss also will summarize some of the major types and sources of water contamination, and finally discuss how natural and constructed wetlands are beneficial to human society for maintenance and improvement of water quality. The event is free and open to the public.
