SIGN UP EARLY FOR FALL SEMESTER. New students planning to enroll at Indiana State University Evansville for the Fall, 1979 semester are invited to pre-register for their classes on the 1st and 2nd Mondays in June.

This is a new program at ISUE, designed to help new students reserve places for themselves in the classes of their choice

for next Fall. By pre-registering, students also are able to plan schedules for part-time jobs, etc., far ahead of the normal date.

TUITION AND FEES WILL NOT BE CHARGED FOR PRE-REGISTRATION -- they will not be payable until actual confirmation of registration in the Fall.

New part-time and evening students, as well as freshmen and transfers, are welcome to attend pre-registration. The schedule is as follows:

NEW MAILING INFORMATION: Effective July 15, 1979, there will be a change in dimensional standard for letter size mail as listed below:

1. Any envelope, card, or other piece of mail under height of $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x length of 5" will not be mailable under any circumstance.
2. Any envelope, card, or other piece of mail which is under seven thousandths (.007) of an inch thick will not be mailable under any circumstance.
3. Any envelope, card, or other piece of mail will be subject to a 7¢ surcharge under the following rules:
 - a. All first class mail weighing one ounce or less that exceeds any of these dimensions: $6\frac{1}{8}$ " high, $11\frac{1}{2}$ " long, or $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick.
 - b. Single piece third class mail weighing two ounces or less that exceeds any of these dimensions: $6\frac{1}{8}$ " high, $11\frac{1}{2}$ " long, or $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick.

Note: The surcharge is on oversized, but lightweight items. Do not assume that all large envelopes, such as the popular 9" x 12" flat size, will require the 7¢ surcharge. This is not true. In most instances, a large envelope will carry several ounces of material; hence, will not be subject to the extra charge.

FORMS THAT FLOAT. Artists combine the natural elements of the environment with man-made forms and electronic music to create Forms That Float.
