***Southern Indiana Review* available mid-October; Spring issue planned**

Southern Indiana Review, the national literary magazine published by University of Southern Indiana, will be available after October 5 at Barnes and Noble Booksellers of Evansville and Golden Raintree Books of New Harmony. Price is \$10 at the stand and \$18 for a one-year subscription that includes two issues. A spring issue will be available in April.

"The quality of available writing, the demand for more literary works, and the expansion of USI's School of Liberal Arts served as catalysts for adding an additional issue in spring," said James McGarrah, editor. The magazine has been published annually in the autumn since 1993.

The biannual collection of contemporary poetry, fiction, non-fiction, and book reviews, is illustrated with photographs of many forms of artwork by five artists. It also includes fiction by Michigan writer Tom Watson, poetry and fiction by Victoria Redel, poetry by Jared Carter, and a book review by Patti Aakhus, USI instructor in English, and works by 20 other contemporary writers.

"The fall 2000 issue contains a good cross-section of free verse, poetry, and imaginative short stories; plus outstanding fiction and artwork," said McGarrah of the 104-page issue.
