Book fair

The University of Southern Indiana Children's Center will host its semi-annual fund-raising Scholastic Book Fair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. daily, November 12 through 16, in the lobby of the Orr Center on campus.

The center receives cash and free books based on sales made at the fair. Previous support helped the center develop a children's library. Proceeds this year will benefit documentation projects that record the work of children at the center.

The state-licensed center also is accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children. It offers programs for 2-year-olds and for ages 3 to 6 as well as half-day preschool.

The career and graduate school fair is designed for students, alumni, and recruiters in the business, liberal arts, and science and engineering fields.
