A Basic Parish Nurse Education Program will be presented Thursday through Sunday, September 27 through 30, at Kordes Enrichment Center in Ferdinand, Indiana. Parish nursing is the specialized practice of professional nursing focusing on promotion of health and wholeness within the context of a faith community. Presented in a retreat setting, the program will support continued growth in spiritual formation as well as the knowledge, attitudes, and skills central to the parish nurse role.
