Dr. James R. Blevins, dean of the University of Southern Indiana School of Liberal Arts, has announced the arrival of a Fulbright exchange teacher and the appointment of four new faculty members.

Werner O. Filzmann, a senior teacher at the Gymnasium (high school) in Selb, West Germany, is the Fulbright exchange professor who has traded places with Dr. Susan Smith Wolfe, USI assistant professor of German. Filzmann attended Goethe Gymnasium in Regensburg, West Germany, the University of Regensburg, and Teachers Training College, Regensburg.

The new faculty members are Karen Bonnell, instructor in communications; Daniel R. Craig, assistant professor of music and director of USI's Mid-America Singers; Dal M. Herring, chair of the Communications Department and professor of communications; and Steven Williford, director of Theatre and artistic director of New Harmony Theatre.

Bonnell received an A.A.S. from Henderson Community College, B.S. from USI, and M.A. from Western Kentucky University. She previously was managing editor of WFIE-TV, Evansville.

Craig earned a B.A. in voice performance from Murray State University and an M.M. in choral conducting from the University of Illinois. He was director of choirs at Casper College, Casper, Wyoming.

Dr. Herring received his B.A. from A&M College of Texas, M.A. from Sul Ross State University, and Ph.D. from Texas A&M University. He was professor of journalism and associate director of the School of Communications at Northern Arizona University, Flagstaff.

Williford received a B.F.A. from East Carolina University and M.F.A. from the University of Washington, Seattle. He has been working with the New Harmony Theatre for the past two seasons.
