


WOMEN'S SCOTT NAMED GLVC

University of Southern Indiana sophomore Shelly Scott has been named Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) player of the week. Scott, a native of McCordsville, Ind., set a new single game scoring record for a women's player with 38 points against the University of Indianapolis on Thursday. She scored 56 points and hauled down 26 rebounds in two conference games. Scott is averaging 20.4 points and 10.5 rebounds per game.

The Lady Eagles (3-8 & 1-3 GLVC) host Pikeville College tonight before taking to the road. The Lady Eagles play at Indiana Technology Thursday before returning to conference play on Saturday when they play at Indiana-Purdue at Fort Wayne.

The men (8-4 & 2-2 GLVC) are riding a three-game winning streak into Saturday's matchup against Indiana-Purdue at Fort Wayne. The Eagles defeated Bellarmine College 69-66 on Saturday for their second strait GLVC win.

The Eagles are led by junior guard Chris Johnson who is averaging 14.1 points and 4.0 assists per game. The 6-0 Danville, Vir., native also leads the team in dunks with 10. Sophomore Ilo Mutombo leads the way in rebounding averaging 6.8 per game.

Probable starters for Saturday's matchup are - Chris Johnson, G, 14.1 ppg, 3.1 rpg; John Schellenberg, G, 5.5 ppg, 1.0 rpg; Ilo Mutombo, C, 8.1 ppg, 6.8 rpg; Kip Brownfield, F, 4.1 ppg, 2.5 rpg; Dennis Humphrey, F, 6.0 ppg, 3.3 rpg.
