Openings available in USI's summer programs for children and adolescents

University of Southern Indiana offers multiple one-week Super Summer sessions and special enrichment courses for children of varying ages. Classes are held both on-campus and off-campus in June and July.

The programs to be held Monday through Friday, June 14 - 18 at USI include the computer technology topics of World Wide Web discovery and learning word processing, spreadsheets, and graphic design; experiments in science; home alone instructions and babysitting (diapering included!); art; and discoveries in pre-history.

The Evansville Day School, 3400 N. Green River Road, is an alternate site for summer programs. The Evansville Day School classes will be held Monday, July 12 through Friday, July 16 and include include scientific experiments and "magic" with science; German language and culture; drama with professional actors; cartooning; and environmental science.

The summer also offers a horse lover's clinic Monday and Tuesday, June 21 - 22, or Monday, July 19, at Cedarwood Farms, 12201 Old State Road; a computer class for parents and kids on three Monday evenings June 14 - 18 at USI, so that parents can attend the class and learn with their children, and SAT 1 preparations Saturday, June 19, and Saturday, June 26.

Instructors are teachers from local school corporations, USI faculty, and other professionals.

Class times and durations vary. Most classes are either morning or afternoon for one week, while the horse clinic is five hours per day for two days and the SAT 1 preparations classes are six hours for one day. Registration fees also vary.
