

The Screaming Eagles finished fourth in the GLVC's Green Division last season and qualified for the GLVC Tournament for the first time since 1993. USI finished the 1996 campaign with a 14-19 overall record, 6-10 GLVC.

The key for the Eagles in 1997 will be to develop the ability to deliver the knock out blow. Last season, USI was up 2-0 or 2-1 in games in four matches, two in the GLVC, and lost all four.

The squad also came back from a 2-0 deficit only to lose to Indiana University/Purdue Univer-sity- Ft. Wayne, in the rally-scoring fifth game. IPFW went on to win the GLVC and play in the NCAA Division II Tournament.

Head Coach Kelly Boyd is guiding the team for the sixth season. Boyd, USI's all-time winningest volleyball coach, has a 77-70 record in five seasons at USI.

Losing only two starters and three letterwinners from last year's squad, Coach Boyd has an experienced team returning to compete, including six letterwinners.

Leading the way is the team's jack-ofall-trades, senior outside/middle hitter Jamie Roth (Springfield, Ill.). Roth led the team with 47 aces; was second on the squad with 334 kills and 264 assists; and third on the club with a .231 hitting percentage.

Senior middle hitter Rebecca Tillema (Wheatfield, Ind.), the team's heavy hitter, returns for her senior season. Tillema, an All-GLVC performer last year, led the squad with 372 kills and a .273 hitting percentage, eighth in the GLVC. Tillema also led with 187 blocks – 90 solo and 97 assisting – second in the GLVC.

This season, Roth and Tillema will be attempting to rewrite parts of the USI record book. Roth, USI's all-time leader in aces, is second all-time in kills and third all-time in digs. Tillema is third all-time in blocks solo and assists, and tied for fifth in kills.

Completing the senior class is outside hitter Stephanie Shidler (Plymouth, Ind.). Shidler was second on the team with 33 aces and fourth on the team with 213 kills.

While the three seniors are looking at their final season of competition, sophomore outside/middle hitter **Danielle Peter** (Tell City, Ind.) is hoping to improve in her second year. Peter, one of the GLVC's strongest freshmen a year ago, was third on the team with 275 kills and second on the team with a .234 hitting percentage.

Among the three seniors and two sophomores are a pair of juniors, setter Tai Richardson (Cayuga, Ind.) and outside hitter Qwin Daniels (Hammond, Ind.). In 32 matches, Richardson led the Eagles in assists for the second season in a row with 898, eighth in the GLVC. Daniels, in 21 matches.

This season Coach Boyd brings in seven players, making this one of the largest recruiting classes.

Leading the way are Amy and Angie Hughes (Washington, Ind.), a set of twins who are transferring from Wabash Valley College. They were All-Region and All-Great Rivers Athletic Conference at WVC.

Angie Hughes led WVC in kills and digs last season, while Amy was second in both categories.

Joining the Hughes are four freshmen from Indiana. They are Emily Mcintosh, an outside hitter/defensive specialist from Monroeville, Ind.; Carly Messmann, a setter from Ft. Wayne; Amy Steele, an outside hitter from Sullivan; and Michelle Lilly, from Valparaiso, Ind.

Steele was first team All-Conference and All-County as a senior at Sullivan High School.

The Eagles start the 1997 season in the Indiana University/Purdue University Indianapolis Tournament on Friday, August 29, before traveling south to play in the University of Alabama-Huntsville Tournament on Friday, September 5.

The home opener will be on Tuesday, September 9, when Oakland City University visits the Physical Activities Center. USI will open GLVC action on the road this season against the GLVC defending champion IPFW Lady 'Dons. The first GLVC match at the PAC will be on Saturday, September 20, against Northern Kentucky University.

The GLVC Tournament will be on Thursday, November 13-15, at a site to be determined.

HEAD COACH KELLY BOYD

Kelly Boyd, the all-time winningest volleyball coach at the University of Southern Indiana, is 77-70 (.524) in five seasons at the helm of the Screaming Eagles. Boyd also has the longest tenure of any volleyball coach at USI since the program was created in 1980.

Last season, Boyd directed the Eagles to a berth in the Great Lakes Valley Conference Tournament for the second time in four years. Boyd's Eagles, 14-19 overall and 6-10 in conference play, finished fourth in the GLVC's Green Division, the first year of divisional play in the league.

She became USI's all-time winningest volleyball coach in 1995, a season that saw the Eagles go 14-15 overall, 9-11 GLVC, and miss the GLVC Tournament by one match.

In 1994, Boyd completed her third straight winning season with the Eagles, leading them to a 15-14 overall record and a seventh-place finish in the GLVC. In 1993, Boyd led the Eagles to a 20-9 record and a 6-3 fifth-place finish in the Great Lakes Valley Conference.

Boyd became the volleyball head coach in 1992 and in that first year led the Eagles to a 14-13 mark and a 5-4 GLVC record, finishing in the upper division. During 1992 and 1993, she was an assistant coach on the women's basketball team in addition to being the head volleyball coach.

While a graduate assistant coach for women's basketball at Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond, Kentucky, Boyd earned her master's in physical education/sports administration. The native of Argenta, Ill., earned an associate degree from Lincoln College, while playing varsity basketball and softball. She went on to receive a bachelor's in physical education in 1990 from Truman State University (formerly Northeast Missouri State University), where she continued her varsity basketball career from 1987-90.

In addition to her duties as volleyball coach, Boyd teaches in the USI Physical Education Department.
