BABCOCK AND WILCOX DONATES EQUIPMENT TO ISUE. Babcock and Wilcox of Mt. Vernon, Indiana has donated two surplus Perkins Elmer Laser Interferometer gauges to the Division of Engineering Technology at ISUE.

The gauges, one new and one used, measure direct distances up to 150 feet providing measurements of lengths in English or metric units. The instruments automatically compensate for atmospheric effects and material temperature and are useful in instrumentation, machine shop practice, construction, and surveying.

According to DR. ANTHONY TILMANS, Chairman of the Division of Engineering Technology, "If we were to purchase this kind of equipment, we would have to spend approximately \$25,000 on each gauge. This type of support from local industry is vital to the development of a new program such as ours at ISUE."

Donation of the gauges was coordinated by WILLIAM STAMETS, Chief Engineer at Babcock and Wilcox, Mt. Vernon Works. He serves as a member of the Engineering Technology Industrial Advisory Board at ISUE and is an adjunct lecturer.

INDIANA ARTS COMMISSION AWARDS GRANTS TO ISUE. The Indiana Arts Commission has awarded two grants totaling \$5,100.00 to ISUE.
