Ms. Carol Schneider, a University of Southern

Indiana junior, received the \$300 Old National Bank "Best of Show" award for her painting, "Forbidden Fruit" in the 1989 Student Art Exhibition at the University.

The exhibition remains on public display from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily through Sunday, April 30, in the University Center. It was juried by Dan Engelke, who was instrumental in the 1970s in establishing ceramic and design programs for the USI Art Department. Engelke was with USI seven years and now is an associate professor of art at Purdue University. His work has won numerous regional and national awards.
