

# Third time will be the charm for USI Volleyball

The University of Southern Indiana volleyball hopes the third time will be the charm in the Great Lakes Valley Conference Tournament.

The Screaming Eagles made their second consecutive trip to the GLVC Tournament in 1997, going a step further than the year before, winning a first round game before bowing out in the semi-finals. The Eagles finished the year with a 17-11 overall record, 9-7 in the GLVC regular season.

USI is hoping to take that next big step and challenge for the conference title in 1998.

To meet the challenge, USI Head Coach **Kelly Boyd** and the Eagles will have to replace three players who had become fixtures on the USI team. The squad will fill the void created by the graduation of outside hitter Jamie Roth, who was named All-GLVC in 1997; middle hitter Rebecca Tillema, who was named All-GLVC in 1996; and outside hitter Stephanie Shidler.

Of a possible 348 matches and 1,305 games over four years, these three players played in 334 matches and 1,220 games. Roth played all 116 matches and 434 of a possible 435 games in her four seasons.

Roth, who led the Eagles with a .278 hitting percentage, 315 kills, and 368 digs in 1997, finishes her career first all-time in service aces and digs, and second in kills. Tillema, who was first on the team with 131 blocks, and second with a .232 hitting percentage and 296 kills, is second all-time in blocks and third in kills.

While USI will miss these three players, the cupboard is not bare for Coach Boyd. USI returns nine letter winners for the 1998 season.

Leading the way for the 1998 team is junior outside hitter **Danielle Peter** (Tell City, Indiana). Peter, who continues to improve each season, was third on the team with 170 kills and 219 digs.

Joining Peter on the front line for their senior season are outside/middle hitters **Angie and Amy Hughes** (Washington, Indiana). Angie finished the season with a .224 hitting percentage and 110 kills. Amy, who missed 16 matches with a knee injury, had 45 kills and a .270 hitting percentage in 12 matches.

USI returns two experienced setters with sophomore setter **Carly Messman** (Ft. Wayne, Indiana) and senior setter/defensive specialist **Tai Richardson** (Cayuga, Indiana). Messman led the team as a freshman with 812 assists and 42 service aces, while Richardson, who ranks second all-time in assists at USI, had 142 assists and 154 digs.

Along the back line the Eagles return a strong defense. Sophomore outside hitter/defensive specialist **Emily McIntosh** (Monroeville, Indiana) played in all 28 matches as a freshman and had 147 digs and 17 service aces. Senior **Qwin Daniels** (Hammond, Indiana), who had a strong finish in 1997, played in 25 matches and had 62 digs in 45 games played.

USI has added one transfer and seven incoming freshmen.

Middle/outside hitter **Carla Butts** (Cayuga, Indiana) is a junior transfer from Danville Community College. Butts was named All-Conference twice at DCC, first team in 1997 and second team in 1998.

Butts and Leon are joined by six freshmen, which represent the future of the USI program. The Class of 2001 including outside hitters **Summer Hall** (Orleans, Indiana), **Ivy Krom** (Rochester, Indiana), **Kristi Dukes** (Kendallville, Indiana), **Regan Lynch** (Evansville, Indiana); and **Jan Johnson** (Bloomfield, Indiana); middle hitter **Audra Ruhe** (Ferdinand, Indiana); and defensive specialist **Eileen Stahura** (Whiting, Indiana).

## HEAD COACH KELLY BOYD

Kelly Boyd, the all-time winningest volleyball coach at the University of Southern Indiana, is 94-81 (.537) in six seasons at the helm of the Screaming Eagles. Boyd holds the longest tenure of any volleyball coach at USI since the program was created in 1980.

Last year, Boyd steered the Eagles to their first winning season since 1994 and a second consecutive GLVC playoff appearance. USI was 17-11 overall and second in the GLVC's Green Division at 9-7.

In 1996 Boyd directed the Eagles to a berth in the Great Lakes Valley Conference Tournament for the second time in four years. Boyd's Eagles, 14-19 overall and 6-10 in conference play, finished fourth in the Green Division, the first year of divisional play in the league.

Boyd became USI's all-time winningest volleyball coach in 1995, a season that saw the Eagles go 14-15 overall, 9-11 GLVC, and miss the GLVC Tournament by one match.

In 1994, Boyd completed her third straight winning season with the Eagles, leading them to a 15-14 overall record and a seventh-place finish in the GLVC. In 1993, Boyd directed the Eagles to a 20-9 record and a 6-3 fifth-place finish in the Great Lakes Valley Conference.

Boyd became the head volleyball coach in 1992 and in that first year led the Eagles to a 14-13 mark and a 5-4 GLVC record, finishing in the upper division. During 1992 and 1993, she was an assistant coach on the women's basketball team in addition to being the head volleyball coach.

While a graduate assistant coach for women's basketball at Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond, Kentucky, Boyd earned her master's degree in physical education/sports administration. The native of Argenta, Illinois, earned an associate's degree from Lincoln College, while playing varsity basketball and softball. She went on to receive a bachelor's in physical education in 1990 from Truman State University (formerly Northeast Missouri State University), where she continued her varsity basketball career from 1987-90.

In addition to her duties as volleyball coach, Boyd teaches in the USI Physical Education Department.


