Rebecca J. Englert, who has been program director and instructor in radiologic technology at the University of Southern Indiana since 1981, has assumed new duties as coordinator of business and professional development programs in USI's Office of Continuing Education and Extended Services.

Mrs. Englert assumed the responsibilities previously held by Larry Bohleber, who was promoted to manager of business development programs last year. She eventually will take over as director of the innovative Management Diagnostic Center which identifies management prospects and recommends training programs to aid their progress. Bohleber said they expect to increase the emphasis on professional development in such areas as accounting, real estate, secretarial, and teaching.

Mrs. Englert, a native of Boonville, Indiana, graduated from USI in 1983 with bachelor's degrees in political science and health services and currently is working towards a Master of Public Administration at Indiana State University. She also has an associate degree from Florida Junior College in Jacksonville (1978) and became certified in radiologic technology in 1972 in the University of Evansville/St. Mary's Medical Center program.

Mrs. Englert recently was elected to a second term as president of the Evansville MPA (Master of Public Administration) Association. She also is serving on the Mayor's Task Force to study city-county government consolidation for Evansville and Vanderburgh County.
