

# Message from Dr. David Rice President, University of Southern Indiana

Change is an elixer, and the University of Southern Indiana is invigorated. Many changes have taken place in the past academic year. The institution has become Indiana's sixth state university, completing its transition from a regional campus to a comprehensive state university. With this came a change in the institution's name, its governance structure, and its scope. The first master's degree program, in industrial management, was added this year, and the approval of the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools was extended to graduate level work. Student housing, adjacent to campus, brought changes in the student life program as more than 500 students became residents of the Mid-America Student Housing apartment complex.

Developments such as these are synergistic. It seems that each new activity adds its own energy and spins off in new and challenging directions while creating other developments. We have been fortunate to channel this energy into a positive force, using change as an opportunity for renewal — to improve programs, to reach for higher goals, to better serve an increasing constituency.

In all that the institution undertakes, whether it is in the classroom or on the playing court, the spirit of renewal and rededication is applied. This is the spirit of which Governor Robert Orr spoke when he convened the first meeting of the USI Board of Trustees this past summer. He said "There is a certain spirit which prevails here...which has helped this institution grow and flourish." And as he praised that spirit, he also challenged each of us — professors, students, employees, trustees, and friends — to use that spirit to shape the direction of this University, saying, "We have a brand new institution being created. You will all have a hand in seeing that it comes to pass...as a strong and vibrant institution..."

We invite you to join us as we take up that challenge and enthusiastically work to achieve this newest goal.

### Introducing THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN INDIANA

Nestled in the gently rolling hills of southern Indiana is a public university campus of 4,000 students midway between Evansville and Mt. Vernon, Indiana. Although the **University of Southern Indiana** is Indiana's newest state university, it has existed for 20 years as a regional campus of Indiana State University. Legislation enacted by the Indiana General Assembly in 1985 established USI as a separate state university.

People who learn about USI remark that it is almost ideal . . . in location, size, curricular and career opportunities, academic strength, and cost.

The Southern Indiana **location** offers a temperate climate year round and the campus location is easily accessible, via interstate highways, to major metropolitan areas in the Midwest as well as in Indiana.

The **size** is ideal for students who like to know their professors personally and who like learning in small classes. The student to faculty ratio is 19 to 1, and all classes are taught by well-qualified faculty members. There are no teaching assistants at USI.

**Curricular and career opportunities** are available in more than 60 academic majors in the areas of allied health, business, education, engineering technology, humanities, science and mathematics, and social science. A master of science degree is offered in industrial management and other master's programs are offered in specialized areas in cooperation with other universities. Approximately 5,000 persons have earned degrees from the University since the first class was graduated in 1971. It counts among its alumni successful leaders in business,

medicine, broadcasting, education, visual arts, and government. These successful leaders speak to the **strong academic preparation** they earned as undergraduates at the university.

**Tuition** is reasonable. This year Indiana residents will pay \$43.00 per credit hour and out-of-state students will pay \$106.00. There is no matriculation fee.

The University of Southern Indiana campus was developed according to a master plan, so it is modern and well-planned. It occupies 300 acres and an additional 1100 acres surrounding the Mid-America University Center are available for future development. All the buildings are fairly new — constructed between 1969 and 1980. There are five major buildings — the Administration and Science Center, University Library, University Center, Technology Center, and Physical Activities Center — which are complemented by an Art Center, Children's Center, Physical Plant, WSWI Radio Center, Theatre, and the IU School of Medicine's Evansville Center.

About 600 students live on campus in the Mid-America Student Housing Complex. Other students commute from nearby apartment complexes or from their houses in neighboring communities.

The University of Southern Indiana is fully accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, and carries accreditation from other accrediting agencies for programs in education, engineering technology, and allied health.




#### **JEFF EMBREY**
