March 31 is the deadline to sign up for a three-day trip to Chicago April 15-17, sponsored by the University of Southern Indiana Office of Continuing Education as an opportunity to see the nationally touring exhibition of works by America painter Georgia O'Keeffe.

Kathryn Waters, head of the USI art department, will accompany the group and provide background information to enhance the enjoyment of O'Keeffe's paintings, which combine bold expression with intimate observation in a way that has affected the work of many artists in this century.

Art lovers will not want to miss seeing the 120 pieces of O'Keeffe's work on exhibit at the Chicago Art Institute. The group will leave USI at 8 a.m. Friday and return at 9:30 p.m. Sunday, staying two nights at the Palmer House in The Loop, convenient to fine dining, the Art Institute, and shopping on State Street and Michigan Avenue. There will be plenty of free time for personal enjoyment; theater information will be provided as it becomes available.
