

A five-week course covering fundamental principles of daily commodity futures trading will be offered by the University of Southern Indiana Office of Continuing Education, starting Tuesday, February 21.

The commodity futures market provides an opportunity for investors to speculate on future prices of farm crops, metals, and other products. The USI course will teach market analysis, trend projection, chart maintenance, and rules to minimize risk and maximize gain. Farmers will receive special assistance in learning to market grains for greater profits.
