USI VOLLEYBALL LOOKING TO TAKE THE NEXT STEP IN 1994

The University of Southern Indiana volleyball Screaming Eagles are looking to take the next step: win a Great Lakes Valley Conference championship.

The Eagles, who made the GLVC post-season tournament for the second time in three seasons, were 20-9 overall, 6-3 in the GLVC regular season, and finished fifth in the conference tournament in 1993. To repeat and build on last year, the Eagles must replace last season's team leaders, middle hitter Sheri Kaiser and setter Michelle Weesies.

Kaiser was the first volleyball Eagle to ever be named to the American Volleyball Coaches Association's Great Lakes All-Region team and GTE/CoSIDA Academic All-American. She set USI singleseason records for hitting percentage (.391) and kills (577) in 1993. The 1994 graduate also was ranked second nationally in kills.

Weesies, the starting setter the past three seasons, set the school single game (68), single-season (1,126) and career (2,152) records for assists in 1993.

To begin the season, USI will return six players, led by seniors **Heidi Bullock** (Cannelburg, Ind.), a 5-7 setter/outside hitter, and **Shawna Kuester** (Ft. Branch, Ind.), a 5-9 outside hitter.

Bullock, who became an unexpected threat as an outside hitter last season, set USI single-season records for digs (301) and service aces (50). She also had 93 kills

and 27 assists in 1993. Kuester, who ranks fifth all-time in digs at USI, was third on the team in kills (202), tied for second in blocks solo (30), and second in blocking assists (58).

Returning as juniors are 5-8 outside hitter Michelle Welp (Jasper, Ind.) and 5-8 defensive specialist Tanya Broughton (Marengo, Ind.). In 1993, Welp was second on the team in kills (225) and hitting percentage (.236), while Broughton was third in aces (41) and had 109 digs.

Entering their second season at USI is 5-10 sophomore outside/middle hitter Andrea Miller (Ft. Branch, Ind.) and 5-7 sophomore outside hitter/defensive specialist Teresa Billings (Newburgh, Ind.). Miller was fourth on the team in kills (158) in 26 matches. Billings had three kills and 16 digs in eight matches last season.

To give the Eagles depth this year, six freshman have been added to the team. Joining the Eagles are 5-6 defensive specialist Tami Emerick (Mishawaka, Ind.), 5-7 outside hitter/defensive specialist Natalie Folz (Evansville, Ind.), 5-8 outside hitter Jennifer Kinter (Corydon, Ind.), 5-2 setter Angela Kaho (Lyons, Ind.), 5-10 outside hitter Jennifer Kintner (Central, Ind.), 5-10 setter Jamie Roth (Springfield, Ill.), 5-10 middle hitter Stephanie Shidler (Plymouth, Ind.), and 6-0 middle hitter Rebecca Tillema (Wheatfield, Ind.).

HEAD COACH KELLY BOYD

Kelly Boyd begins her third season as head volleyball coach at the University of Southern Indiana. She led the Eagles to a 20-9 record and a 6-3 fifth-place finish in the Great Lakes Valley Conference.

Boyd became the volleyball head coach in 1992 and in that first year, led the Eagles to a 14-13 mark and a 5-4 GLVC record, finishing in the upper division. During her first two seasons as volleyball coach, Boyd also was an assistant coach on the women's basketball team.

While a graduate assistant coach for women's basketball at Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond, Kentucky, Boyd earned her master's degree in physical education/sports administration. She is a native of Argeta, Ill., and earned her bachelor's degree in physical education in 1990 from Northeast Missouri State University, where she played varsity basketball from 1987 to 1989.

In addition to her duties as volleyball coach, Boyd teaches in the USI Physical Education Department.
