Voter registration blitz, debate party to bring election center stage on USI campus

The University of Southern Indiana is undertaking an ambition goal of registering more than 1,000 USI students to vote before this fall's general election.

USI's "Squawk the Vote" campaign officially kicks off tomorrow with a Voter Registration Blitz planned from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday, September 20 outside the University Center on the USI campus. USI President Dr. Linda L.M. Bennett will be on hand to take a photo with the first registrants.

Through early efforts, more than 250 students have already been registered. Progress during the registration blitz will be made public through a large visual graphic located on the exterior windows of the University Center.

Additionally, on Monday, September 26, the University will be hosting a presidential debate viewing and discussion session from 7 to 10 p.m. in Carter Hall in University Center West. Representative from four major political parties have been invited to attend as well as representative from the USI College Democrats and College Republicans. Wendy Turner-Frey, associate professor of social work and director of the Center for Social Justice Education at USI will give a talk on civility and civil discourse before the debate begins. Discussion will follow once the debate concludes. Matt Hanka, associate professor of political science, will be available at the event for media commentary on the debate.
