Pozzatti to lecture at USI

Professor Emeritus of the Indiana University Art Department Rudy Pozzatti will discuss his art work at 7:30 p.m. Thursday, April 8 in Forum II, located in the Wright Administration Building at the University of Southern Indiana. He also will conduct workshops from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday, April 7, and Thursday, April 8, in the Art Department print studio located in the Technology Center. The three events are open to the public.

Professor Pozzatti is a painter and printmaker and earned a degree from the University of Colorado. Upon graduation, he received a Prix de Rome to spend a year in Italy which had a profound influence on the development of his work; the imagery of that experience echoes in his artwork.

Pozzatti is best known for his intaglio and lithographic prints but has also been involved in theater where he has created stage sets. His experiences as an ambassador for the arts has taken him to most of the European countries as well as the Pacific and Asia.

While teaching at Indiana University, he founded Echo Press which gained an international reputation for the exceptional quality of its published limited edition fine art prints. The press printed for many New York galleries and their artist.
