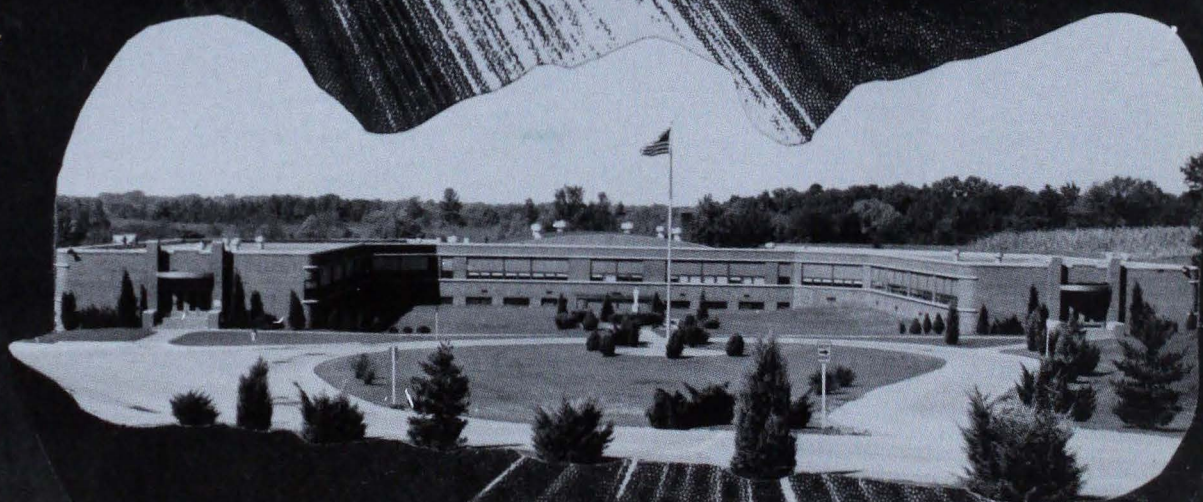



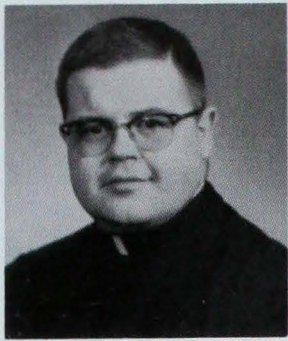
Though Sister would never allow her picture or name to be associated with any of her fascinating products, the usual comment was, "You can see Sister Angela in this alright!"

Sister was transferred to another school this year, and is, no doubt, proving her powers in the same way there.

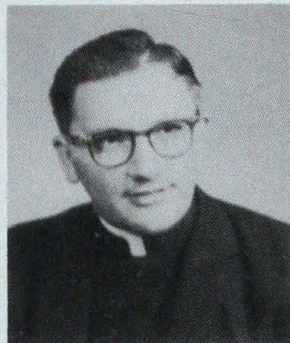
